Alicia Wallace, Marketing Manager with Michigan Works! Northeast Consortium, provided attendance statistics (1400+ students from 22 schools) and feedback from the 2023 MiCareerQuest event on May 4, 2023. In addition, she explained changes that will be implemented for the 2024 MiCareerQuest event, scheduled for May 16, 2024 (same location), including moving from 3 to 2 sessions, changing the start/end times of the event, and offering students 28 minutes per quadrant vs the current 20 minutes per quadrant.
